*Cluster-tilted algebras and quiver mutation*

Quiver mutation is a special case of cluster mutation, as defined by Fomin and Zelevinsky. Cluster-tilted algebras are finite dimensional algebras whose representation theory is closely related to the representation theory of hereditary algebras. We discuss connections, including some recent developments.
