*Twisting self-dual chiral 4-polytopes*

A chiral polytope is a non reflexible polytope with maximal symmetry by rotation. Self-dual chiral polytopes can be properly or improperly. Properly self-dual chiral 4-polytopes can be twisted to obtain regular maps. A similar operation can be done for improperly self-dual chiral 4-polytopes which will give us chiral quotents of the Petrie–Coxeter polyhedra.
