Infinitesimal Freeness

Infinitesimal freeness is an important tool for analysizing spike models in random matrix theory. However, independent copies of many of the standard ensembles in random matrix theory do not exhibit this property. On the other hand universal rules do exist. In this talk I will report on some recent progress with Guillaume Cébron which gives a new kind of free independence in the case of orthogonally invariant matrices.
