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A new necessary condition for the spectral Nevanlinna-Pick problem

Let $U\subset \mathbf{C}$ be the unit disc, and denote by Ω_n the set of $n\times n$ complex matrices with spectral radius <1. The spectral Nevanlinna-Pick problem asks for necessary and sufficient conditions on the (distinct) numbers $z_1,\ldots,z_m\in U$, and on the matrices $W_1,\ldots,W_m\in\Omega_n$ for the existence of a holomorphic function $F\colon U\to\Omega_n$ which satisfies $F(z_j)=W_j$ for all j. This very difficult problem has only been solved for n=m=2. We will present a new Schwarz lemma and apply it to examples with m>2 that could not be decided with previous Schwarz lemmas.
