The Mertens conjecture if proven to be true would imply one of the millennium problems, the Riemann Hypothesis. Odlyzko and te Riele disproved this conjecture by utilizing the Lenstra-Lenstra-Lovász algorithm (LLL). Moreover, the LLL algorithm can efficiently provide solutions for the problem of simultaneous Diophantine approximation.
